Date: Saturday, May 25th

Tee Times: 9-11 a.m.

Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your scheduled tee time to ensure a prompt start.

Course Availability: Closed for non-tournament golfers until 4 p.m.

Grill Room Opening: 8 a.m.

Date: Sunday, May 26th

Start: Shotgun at 1 p.m.

Course Availability: Starting at noon, the course will be closed for non-tournament golfers for the remainder of the day.

Grill Room Opening: Noon

Scoring System: The traditional points system will be used to calculate scores.

Overview:

- Bogey: 1 point
- Par: 2 points
- Birdie: 4 points
- Eagle: 6 points
- Hole-in-one or double eagle: 10 points

Each player will play their own ball, and the total score of each hole for the group will be calculated. It's an exciting format that encourages everyone to give their best shots throughout the tournament.

Participation Fee: The participation fee is \$20 per player. **Team Format:** Teams will be chosen in ABCD format, utilizing the handicap index. This format

aims to create balanced teams and enhance competitiveness among participants. We believe this will add an extra layer of excitement to the tournament.

We're eagerly counting down the days to the Memorial Day Tournament and we hope you are too!

Get ready for an unforgettable weekend packed with fantastic golf, camaraderie, and spirited competition.
